DECREE

Declaration of Boundaries for a Parish

I, the undersigned Bishop of Jefferson City, hereby state the following in regard to the parish of

St. Patrick, Jonesburg:

Whereas, the formal decree establishing the parochial territory of this parish no longer exists, and there is a need to provide for an orderly record of the boundaries of this parish; and

Whereas, having received the proposal of the former Mexico Deanery on the boundaries of this parish, and after consultation with the Presbyteral Council on 13 October 2020 in accordance with canon 515 §2:

Therefore, by this DECREE, I hereby declare that the territory of this parish shall be bounded by the following:

North – Northern borders of Sections 28, 27, 26, 25 (of R4W & T49N), 30 and 29 (of R3W & T49N) to eastern county line.

South – Southern borders of Section 8 and 7 (of R3W & T47N), 12, 11, 10, 9, 8, and 7 (of R4W & T47N), the eastern border of Section 13 (R5W & T47N) down the eastern border of the county to State lettered Hwy Y, follow Hwy Y west to the intersection of State numbered Hwy 19.

East – Eastern border of Section 29 (of R3W & T49N) down the eastern border of the county to the southeast corner of Section 8 (of R3W & T47N).

West – The intersection of State lettered Hwy Y and State numbered Hwy 19, follow Hwy 19 north to the intersection of Interstate numbered Hwy 70, follow Interstate 70 to the intersection of the median of Section 32 (of R4W & T48N), follow the median up to the intersection of the north border of Section 29 (of R4W & T48N), follow the north border of Section 29 (of R4W & T48N) to the northeastern corner of this section, follow the western border of Sections 21, 16, 9, 4 (of R4W & T48N), 33 and 28 (R4W & T49N).

All things to the contrary notwithstanding.
