Grateful Living: The Joy of Stewardship

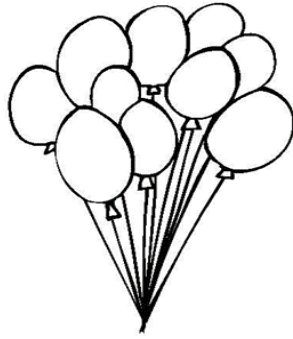
