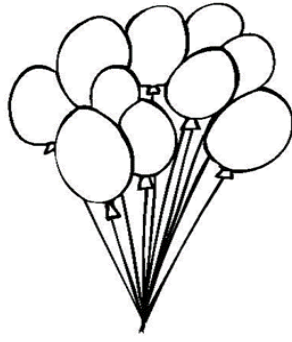
**Burial Service** for Mary Schulenberg will be held this Saturday August 5<sup>th</sup> at 10:00am at St Patrick's Cemetary.

These are the items she usually buys: breakfast items; cereal and oatmeal, lunch items; macaroni and cheese, Vienna sausages, crackers, peanut butter, ravioli, SpaghettiOs, soups, and vegetables, snack items; granola bars, and fruits.
