You will find Catholic Stewardship Renewal (CSR) packets in the back of church/in the pews. In the packet you will find:

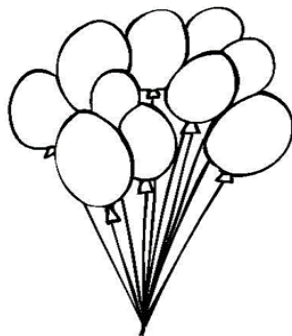
1. A ministry guide that lists all our parish ministries with a description of the ministry.
