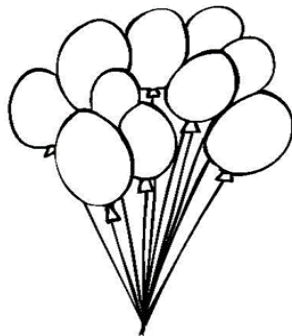
Stewardship Renewal Forms
