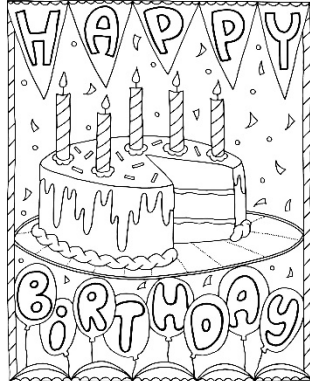
For those preparing for reception of the Easter sacraments this year, may our whole Church be renewed and invigorated by the celebrations of baptism, confirmation and First Holy Communion.
